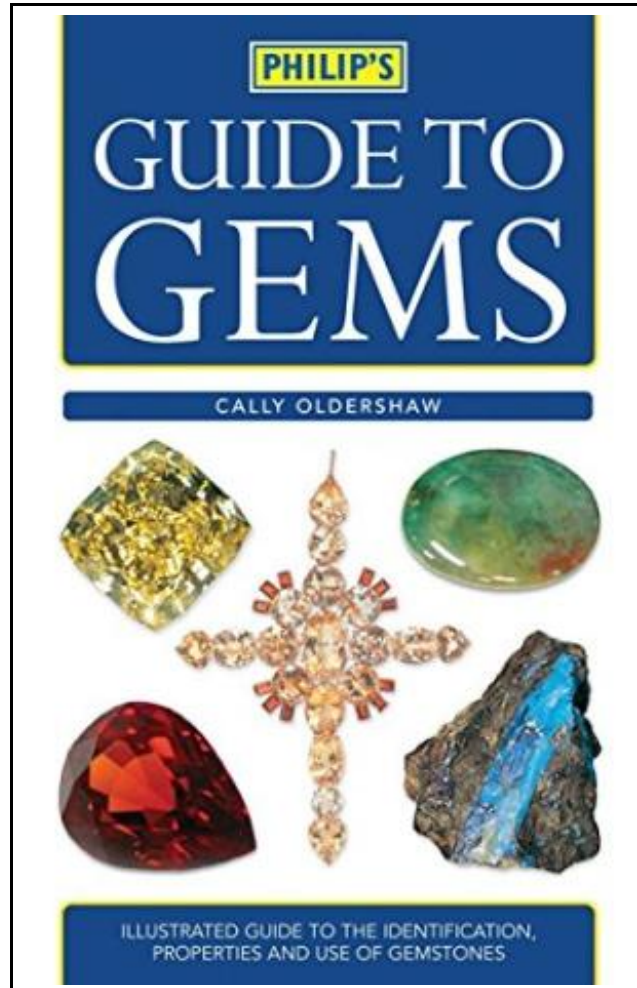

She is the author of DK's Gemstones which sold over 5 million copies worldwide.
